### SHORT BIO

---

**Silvia Aru (PhD)** is an assistant professor of Economic and Political Geography at the University of Turin. Her research interests encompass migration policies and their socio-territorial impact and related issues of justice and socio-spatial inclusion/exclusion. On these topics, she conducted a Marie Curie fellowship at the University of Amsterdam (2018-2020) titled “A Place for the Asylum Seekers. European migration policies and their socio-spatial impacts” (PASS). Her research activity has found, over time, a synthesis in several publications in peer-reviewed journals, in two monographs addressing the geography of migration, as well as in talks at multiple national and international conferences and seminars. She is a co-editor of the *Rivista Geografica Italiana* and an EU external expert to assist in evaluating grant applications, projects and tenders.
